**NOMINATIONS FOR BOARD OF MINISTRY AND ANNUAL CONFERENCE DELEGATES—**The Nominating Task Team is receiving nominations from our Covenant Partners (members) for Annual Conference Delegates and the Board of Ministry.

**Annual Conference Delegates** serve for one year (June, 2017 thru May 2018). We will (depending on our membership numbers) elect 7-9 delegates and 2-3 reserve delegates. Delegates represent our church at the Southern Michigan Annual Conference (June 15-16). Delegates serve as liaisons between the congregation and the Annual Conference, representing the local church's interests in legislative actions as well as representing the mission of the Conference to the congregation.

**Board of Ministry** members are elected for three year terms. In this year of transition, we will elect: one member for a one-year term, two for two years, and three for three years. The Board of Ministry oversees policy that supports the mission of the church. They ensure that our church is on mission, that we are adequately staffed for our mission, that staff are adequately cared for, that we are fiscally solvent, legally compliant, risk averse, and that we are in line with the Free Methodist Church in doctrine, ethos, and mission.
